All commercially available solid fuel motors will be allowed at LDRS XIV. Only experimental motors **or** rockets with **total impulses of 1280 N-sec and over** will be flown at FireBALLS 005. Alternative fuel motors for either launch must be authorized in advance by the Board of Directors of Tripoli and AERO-PAC. Biodegradable wadding is required for environmental reasons. Night-launched rockets require a visual beacon (e.g., strobe light) visible during the flight, and are limited to 3000 feet AGL for safety reasons.

AERO-PAC Range Safety Regulations are enforced at all AERO-PAC rocket launches. Copies of the AERO-PAC Range Safety Regulations are available on request. E-mail ldrs@aeropac.org; Internet: <http://www.aeropac.org/aeropac/ldrs.html>; or call (805) 239-3818 for maps and more information.

Flyers' badges for LDRS and FireBALLS will be issued at the launch site for each event. Please note that registration for FireBALLS requires an additional \$10 fee. LDRS launch hours will be from 0800 to 1600 hours daily. Expect afternoon winds and plan accordingly. A night launch will be held on Friday from 2000 to 2200 hours. Remember that all night-launched rockets must have a visual beacon and are limited to 3000 feet AGL. FireBALLS launch hours will be from 0800 to 1500 hours. Teardown and clean up will commence at 1500 hr. on Monday.

The LDRS XIV Banquet will be held on Saturday evening at Bruno's Country Club in Gerlach prior to the Annual Tripoli Membership Meeting. Cost of the banquet is \$15 per person. It may be necessary to serve dinner at two sitting times depending on the number of advance sign-ups. Late sign-ups at the launch will be accepted only on a limited space-available basis. Therefore, reserve your place by returning this form.
